

## CRC JUNIOR HIGH TRACK MEET INFORMATION

**Date, site and time**. FRIDAY APRIL 26, 2019 at Cross County High School. A scratch and add **meeting** will be held in the **Press Box** at the Football Field at **8:15 a.m.** The rain date is Tuesday April 30. **Awards** presentation at conclusion of meet in front of bleachers.

**Adds and Scratches**. The addition of a participant in any event may be permitted in cases where the participant is already entered in the meet and in case no additional heat is required. In case the participant is not already entered, the director may use his own discretion as to whether the entry should be allowed.

### ->Entries. Entries will be made online we will send additional information on Thursday, April 18 these entries will be DUE ON TUESSDAY APRIL 23.

**Field Events**. The first field events will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. The events judges will measure each legal attempt in the long jump, triple jump, discus, and shot. If you are in charge of an event, bring helpers, measuring tapes, etc. Check your rulebook and make sure you know the rules for your assigned event. Starting heights for the high jump and pole vault will be determined from entries and weather conditions of the day.

**Approved Rulings**. The CRC meet will be conducted according to the National Federation Track and Field Rules, and the rulings of the NSAA for district and state competition. Cross County Track policy requires the use of one-eighth inch pyramid spikes.

**Sportsmanship**. "Good Sportsmanship" is the quality of character that strives to be courteous, fair, and respectful to others. A school's quality of sportsmanship is evaluated by others on the basis of the conduct of that school' players, spectators, coaches and school authorities. (CRC Constitution, page 22). Courteous requires officials to prevent violations before they happen when possible. A formal warning to all athletes when they officially check-in should suffice in preventing an athlete from being disqualified for swearing, taunting, or acting disrespectful towards an official.

**Parking**. Please park school vehicles in the Northwest lot and to the north and west end of the facility. Please have your driver stay to the FAR Northwest end of the lot as near to the trees as possible.

**Camp Areas:** All camp areas are required to be outside of the track area, and must stay directly north of the press box and as close to the north and west fence as possible. DO NOT ALLOW CAMPS UNDER THE BLECHERS. Please check and clean up your camp area at the conclusion of the meet.

#### **Cross County Facility Policy**.

- a. The track is an all-weather track with 8 lanes. Wear 1/8 inch pyramid spikes only.
- b. Use tape or chalk for markings on track, runways, or approaches.
- c. No students are allowed in the school. Restrooms are located on the north side of the field house. Dressing rooms are not available.
- d. Starting blocks, hurdles, standards, rakes, and crossbars are furnished.
- e. The shot put and discus platforms are cement; no spikes may be worn for these events. The runways for the LJ, TJ, PV and approach for the HJ are all-weather material: 1/8 inch pyramid spikes only may be used for these field events.
- f. All litter on the field and in the parking areas must be picked up.
- g. No one is to play ball or Frisbee on the infield or lounge on the jump mats.
